ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF CHAPTER 11 CASE

This Chapter 11 case came on for final hearing on December 6, 2011 with respect to the debtor's motion for dismissal filed on April 15, 2011 (record #405), and the joint motion for dismissal filed by Pilgrim Financing, LLC and Arthur D. Pringle III on December 22, 2010 (record #372). The debtor appears by counsel Catherine Molnar-Boncela, and by its principal Sergio Garcia; Arthur D. Pringle III appears by counsel James M. Yannakopoulos and Greg A. Bouwer; Pilgrim Financing, LLC appears by counsel Jonathan Petersen.

Findings of fact and conclusions of law were stated on the record at the December 6, 2011 hearing.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The Chapter 11 case of Kerusso Real Estate, LLC is dismissed.
2. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 349(a), dismissal of the case is accompanied by the following:
 - a. Kerusso Real Estate, LLC is forever barred from initiating a case under Title 11 of the United States Code.
 - b. No property, as defined by 11 U.S.C. § 541(a), of the bankruptcy estate of Kerusso Real Estate, LLC in case number 09-22954 – or which should have comprised property of the estate in that case – shall be included as property of the bankruptcy estate in any case under Title 11 of the United States Code in which the debtor in said case is, or was at any time, an insider of Kerusso Real Estate, LLC [as insider is defined by 11 U.S.C. § 101(31)],

or a relative of an insider of Kerusso Real Estate, LLC [as “relative” is defined by 11 U.S.C. § 101(45)].
